## Moving schools

For most children, moving schools or making that jump from intermediate to high school can be a big deal. If the family works together it can mean a lot less stress all round. Your child will probably be experiencing a mixture of emotions ranging from excitement to a sense of loss and even fear. The move from intermediate or full primary to high school is especially confusing in many ways. Children have to deal with both 'endings' and sadness while at the same time anticipating new beginnings. This may include feelings of excitement and nervous anticipation. ### What's in a name?

On Saturday 1 October, Hobsonville Point hosted an event as part of the Auckland wide Heritage Festival event. Hobsonville Point has been taking part in this event for the past 6 years, with previous events including guided walks, tour of the Mill House, and a ferry trip with heritage talk. This is a great opportunity to celebrate the history of this wonderful area.

This year it was a game/self guided walk, themed around the road names

that reflect the history of Hobsonville Point. Participants were given a challenge sheet to complete – photograph a number of street signs, answer questions about the origin of the name, and were then rewarded with an ice block from Hobby Convenience. Three students from the Hobsonville Point Secondary School helped Hobsonville Land Company organise this – Julia Lim, Emma Johnson and Myles Dawson. The Hobsonville Point Residents Society and Hobsonville Land Company sponsored the ice blocks.



The Warehouse Westgate Fernhill Drive Open 7 Days 8.30am-9pm The roads are named after former Air Force personnel, for example, Hugh Wilson, who served with the Wellington Mounted Rifles at Gallipoli. After being transferred to the Western Front, Wilson was badly gassed at Passchendaele. This caused health problems for the rest of his life. He was awarded the Military Medal for his war service. Wilson served in the Army Service Corps before transferring to the RNZAF. As a squadron leader he was appointed CO of No. 1 Stores Depot on its formation in September 1939 and remained in command when the Depot moved to Te Rapa, Hamilton, in December 1942. He was an avid gardener, along with his wife, Billy. He kept the family supplied with vegetables from his large plot. Much of the family fruit was home grown as well - grapefruit and lemons, tamarillo and even a guava flourished in the extensive gardens. Wilson and his family lived in a number of houses on the station, including the single storey home on Marlborough Crescent.

Road names also reflect the aircraft that came through the Hobsonville airbase, e.g. Meteors, Vickers Vincents, Kittyhawks, Harvards, De Havillands, and the Tiger Moth which was imported by Doug Mill in 1937. Tony Lester (Lester St) lost an eye when he crashed it taking it for a test flight.

Other roads are named after birds, plants and marine life that are present here – e.g. Kanuka Rd, Kotuku Lane, Ponga St, Mapou Rd. There are more wonderful stories about the history of the former Airbase in Bee Dawson's book – 'Hobsonville – Portrait of a Seaplane Station'. There also some wonderful images online at: www.localhistoryonline.org.nz. The West Auckland Research Centre in Henderson is also a fantastic resource for oral recordings of people telling their stories, and has more stories and images from the pre-Air Force era as well.

# Online purchases and shipping

It's crazy to think but we are already just 1 month from December and Christmas!

Buying online is a great way to get some great deals and also knock off your Christmas shopping without the crowds in the malls.

There are a few things to consider to make online shopping a little safer so here is some handy tips.

Shipping is expensive, especially when you live in a rural location - not only that but it is slower. Common practice is that the rural postie signs for your parcel from the main courier and then drops it at your place on their behalf. If you're not home, they will just leave the parcel on the deck/front door with no signature needed. Now here is the worst part - thieves operate in our area all the time but in the next few months they scale up their activity. They drive round in what can pass as a courier van and follow the rural postie, watching where they deliver parcels and a short while later they steal your online purchase. You won't know for a few days until you try and track it and as far as the courier company is concerned it has been delivered. This could be a valuable item moneywise, or more importantly a sentimental item that you can't put a dollar value on - either way you might get your money back from the courier company but you won't always replace what you bought.

Why not think about having your online purchase delivered to work or use the free e-pack service "epickup". Just buy online and have the item delivered to e-pack on Shamrock Drive. Once it arrives they will text you and you can swing by and pick it up. They open from 7.30 till 4.00pm Monday to Friday and will arrange after hours collection in special circumstances. This saves rural courier fees and delivery time and more importantly your

### Health and safety

A quick first aid response can mean all the difference to reduce the severity of an injury. First aid can also help protect businesses, by reducing the impact on productivity and the cost of employees taking leave.

First aid regulations state that if you employ more than 100 people you are required to provide a first aid room and trained first aiders. For smaller businesses, a stocked first aid kit is required and first aider is ideal although may not be legally required. These kits must be made of sturdy material and be designed to protect the contents from damp, dust and contamination. Kits must be clearly identified with a white cross on a green background, easily accessible and its location known to everyone.

### Moana's music



Moana Maniapoto sings what she thinks. The Muriwai Beach musician, known for her band Moana & the Tribe (and formerly the Moahunters) is passionate about Maori culture. And if that means spreading it through her music then so be it.

Recently inducted into the New Zealand Music Hall of Fame (some family said "abducted" or "indicted", which she used in her acceptance speech), Moana is about to release a new music video. Fire in Paradise, filmed at Muriwai Beach, includes hip hop dancer Kaea Pearce and Jamaican dance hall artist Skarra Mucci. "All I had to do was sit and look regal while Kaea leapt about," Moana laughs. An incoming tide added to the drama.

This month Moana is spending a week at Stanford University in San Francisco, facilitating a session with young indigenous leaders from New Zealand, Alaska and Hawaii. In January, Moana heads to Finland with partner Toby Mills, both an award winning film-making team, along with musician Paddy Free. They'll be playing in a festival inside the Arctic Circle. "I'd been there about 12 years ago and this time I'll be more prepared for the cold," Moana says.

She returns for 21 performances with Arts On Tour across the country in April and May.

So why did Moana and Toby decide to live at Muriwai Beach? "Quite happy" in Grey Lynn, Moana says they were fantasising about a second property and saw a home for sale at Muriwai. "I'd lived in Auckland most of my life and had never been to Muriwai," she says. They knew one local family, so decided to sell and shift. She helped form the Waitangi Day festival there but was unable to find a school with a Maori language immersion programme for the youngest of her two children. Her 8-yearold now carpools with another Muriwai family to Westmere School. "We're te reo refugees," Moana says. She speaks Maori to her children and wants to see the language even more used in New Zealand society.

Well-travelled, Moana says Maori culture is popular at large overseas events, but she struggles to get Maori language mu-

sic played on commercial radio here. "People overseas love the sound of it," she says.

Moana says Maori is gaining more acceptance at home, with many Pakeha children becoming versed in the language and culture.

She received a New Zealand Order of Merit for her services to music and Maori, was made an art laureate by the NZ Arts Foundation, and has received widespread recognition for her work. Now in her sixth year living at Muriwai Beach, Moana is involved in many other events too, including the Iron Maori triathlon style event in Napier in which she has entered three Muriwai teams this year. So if you mention you are good at swimming, cycling or running, you might find yourself drafted into a team next year.

# Spray free weed control on your lifestyle block

Spring is here, although one could be fooled with the mercurial weather we have been experiencing locally. The upside of this weather is we have had great rainfall and as I drive around the district working in real estate I can't help but note how green the pasture is.

Unfortunately growing alongside that lush pasture is a variety of weeds which will need to be controlled.

Is there a more environmentally friendly method to address this problem? As you know, there is a huge and bewildering array of herbicide available to kill just about everything, is this the way to go?

Chemicals are expensive (very), need to be stored safely, unused chemicals and containers need to be disposed of responsibly and in some cases at cost, to an approved disposal facility. The alternative to this approach is mulching, should your terrain allow this. Flail mowing (mulching) is a great way to clean up your pasture, not only does it chop up the grass and weeds into



smaller particles to allow for better regeneration it also does not leave ugly windrows all over your paddocks as traditional slashing does. If you are preparing a property for sale, mulching the paddocks will make your property shine and could be the difference when buyers are deciding on which property to purchase. There are a number of lifestyle block maintenance companies out there who can provide you with advice and this service if you do not have the equipment to do it yourself. If you organise a mulching regime, timed around the emergence of particular weeds you will find after a couple of years they will not be the problem they once were and you will have achieved the result without resorting to costly chemicals.

# Constructive trusts on trust owned property

It is commonly thought that trust owned property is not relationship property. However, making improvements to or maintaining the trust property by someone who is not a beneficiary of the trust can sometimes open the door to the court imposing a constructive trust over some of the value contained within the trust.

In essence, a constructive trust is another sort of trust on trust owned assets. An example is an ex-partner relationship partner who has built a house from relationship resources on trust owned property or has just maintained the gardens and house. The Courts have shown a tendency to do this sort of thing up to the present time. For this reason, it is often necessary to make



a property agreement (often called a prenuptial agreement) with any potential claimant against trust property. The property agreement is written to make it clear to any of the parties that any trust owned property is not, and can never be in the future, relationship property. This is an area where specialist legal advice is always justified if you have a concern.

# Sparkn Update

We hope everyone enjoying the slightly drier weather! The water tanks are full up again. Now is the time to consider outdoor lighting and sensor lights. Lighting is the biggest deterrent to opportunist theft at night. It also makes your home safer; with the days getting longer and warmer some general outdoor ambient lighting would be a nice touch if the evening goes into the small hours as it can with good company. We can also provide more decorative lighting for driveways and gardens.

Do you have lights in a hard place to reach? With the cost of LED lamps and fittings it is very cost effective to replace or relamp fittings. The average pay back (based on energy saved) is approximately 1 to 2.5 years. This may sound like a long pay back, but generally LED's are rated to 25,000 to 50,000 hours (10-25 years), your old filament lamp is typically rated at 1000 – 2000 hours, so they will ast quite a bit longer after the two years. Even compact fluorescent lamps are worth replacing as they are rated to about 8000 hours and use twice the energy of an LED while the LED has the advantage of instant full brightness without the warm-up.

### Ginger, pear and cardamom cake

Pre heat oven 170°C 50g butter - melted ½ cup brown sugar 1 tsp ginger

3 pears – peeled, cored and sliced

Line a 23cm round tin and pour the melted butter into the bottom. Combine the brown sugar and ginger together and sprinkle over the butter covering the base. Arrange the sliced pears in a circular pattern on top of the sugar.

- 125g butter
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla essence
- 2 ½ cups flour
- 4 tsp Baking powder
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 ½ tsp ginger
- 1 tsp cardamom
- 1/2 tsp mixed spice
- 1 1/3 cup milk



Cream the butter and sugar, add the eggs and vanilla essence and beat well. Sift all the dry ingredients together and add alternately with the milk. Mix until smooth. Pour over pears and bake for 1 hour until skewer comes out clean. Serve with cinnamon cream and poached pears.

# Paté recipe

500 g chicken livers 4 tbsp brandy 125 g butter 1 large diced onion ½ cup cream 2 tbsp fresh thyme 125 g mushrooms 1 bay leaf 6 rashers bacon extra 200 g butter and bay leaves for decoration 3 tbsp Port



1. Soak Chicken livers in salted water for 1 hour and then drain. 2. Heat butter in pan, add finely diced onion, thyme, bay leaf and finely chopped bacon. Sauté slowly until tender but not brown.

3. Add livers, simmer for 7 min or until cooked. Put cooked mixture into a big bowl. Then add mushrooms, S&P, cream and alcohol to the frying pan. Stir, bring to the boil and simmer until reduced by almost half. Add liquid to cooked mixture. Blend in batches until smooth; if desired pour into individual bowls and place bay leaf on top. Melt the extra butter and spoon a little over the surface of each pot while still warm. Serve with crusty bread, crostinis or crackers, Alongside NoShortcuts Tamarillo Chutney or Feijoa & Ginger Jam.

# The Riverhead

From all accounts the hospitality they received from the original proprietors of this hotel, Thomas and Eliza Deacon, was exceptional and would 'do credit to a much more populous place than Riverhead'.

The Deacons were 'noted for their courtesy and their studious regard to everything which bears upon the comfort of visitors to their house'

Of course I would want to ensure that this could be done with ease, efficiency and effortlessness. Without falling to the

ground or going "bump". Why?

This movement requires strength, coordination, flexibility, breath, self-awareness and balance.

All the things that make up a good healthy human system.

Your ability to literally get down to the ground, and then, get back up again is serious stuff.

# Dog Bites – why are we not learning

With dog bites on the rise in New Zealand we need to all take a more active role in education and learning about what our dogs are telling us. There has been a concern of late that some information being given to children is out dated and potentially dangerous.



If your school is offering education in dog safety please

ensure that they are getting given the latest information and that it is being delivered by a qualified educator.

It was brought to our attention by a concerned parent recently whose daughter was told to yell at the dog if it ran up to her. As an adult I may be able to get away with this – but when it is a 4 year old girl it is wrong and potentially dangerous.

There are 3 golden rules that all of us should remember no matter the age.

1. Always ask permission from the owner and never approach a dog that is alone. You don't know how this dog is going to react. It may be scared; it may not like people in glasses, or hats or people holding umbrellas. The dog may be unwell or deaf. Fear can cause a dog to bite. As an adult it is our responsibility to educate children in how to keep themselves safe in all situations, including how to behave around a dog.

2. Once permission is given by the owner, and the dog knows you are there, then stand to the side of the dog and touch only its shoulder or side. This reduces that chance that you or the child will make eye contact with the dog. It allows the dog to move away should it not want to be touched. Don't stand in front of the dog and try to touch its chin or chest. You wouldn't stand behind a horse; would you. So why stand at the pointy


end of a dog?

3. Stand like a tree if a strange dog approaches you. This turns you into something uninteresting and the dog may lose interest and just walk away.

Dogs have many subtle ways of telling us that they don't want to interact with us. It is our responsibility to learn what they are saying and how to behave around them. #### Explore new walks with your dog

Time to walk: this walk takes about an hour, 10 minutes going at a good pace. You can add extra time to your walk by heading to the beach at two separate opportunities for a play. Distance: 9Km



Difficulty: moderate, there's a lot of deep sand to walk through.

Extra reasons to love this walk: great burn and thigh workout!

Watch out for: possible horses on the track.

Head to Muriwai opposite the horse park, past the golf course. Walk along coast road over the bridge and continue along until the road bears right and you have reached the beach.

You can head up over the dunes onto the beach here for the dogs to have a play. You'll need wet weather foot wear to enjoy it with the dogs, otherwise watch from the dunes as they frolic in the stream.

When you're ready, call your dog and head back on to the gravel road for about 100 metres and you will see a white marker directing horses heading to the left through bush track. Head in here and follow the track meandering right.

This track takes you through varied terrain and quite deep sand. There's greenery in the dunes, loads of beautiful bushes and trees and I love listening to the waves crashing nearby as well as all the bird song from tuis and other natives.

Continue along for about 4.5 kilometres then bear left on the track, taking you on to the beach.

The dogs appreciate the water at this point and it's nice to take a breather here. As you're quite far north at this point the beach is nice and quiet too.

When you're ready head back on to the track and continue north then take a right fork which takes you back out to Coast Road where you can enjoy an easier flat walk back to the car park. (You can add extra to this walk and stay on the track, it will even-



tually take you in to thicker bush, you can head over the steep dunes back on to the beach or follow your nose right and on to Coast Road). Don't forget water for you and the dogs. Poo bags. Sunscreen, a hat and mosquito spray in summer.

#### How to manage eczema

Have you ever suffered from dry itchy skin? It may be that you have eczema. This is a bothersome skin condition which is common in New Zealand. The pattern of eczema is a little different at certain ages, but typically occurs behind the knees or on the inside of the elbows in older children and adults; and often on the faces or trunk of babies. It occurs when the skin becomes irritated and dry. No-one actually knows why some people are susceptible to eczema, but it is possible that genetic factors play a role. It may also be caused by an allergy. Eczema often co-exists with other conditions such as hay fever or asthma.

Sometimes eczema can compromise the skin so much that the skin can become infected. These infections are usually due to bacteria (but can be caused by viruses). Infected eczema can become oozy and sore. Patients with infected eczema can occasionally get a fever and become very unwell. To prevent this from happening, it is important to manage eczema properly. The two most common treatments for eczema are emollients (a bit like moisturisers) and topical steroids (which are applied to the skin). Emollients are very important in the management of eczema. I tell all my patients who suffer from eczema to put them on as often as possible during flare-ups or otherwise. This may be up to four times a day. Emollients are safe, they improve the integrity of the skin and help to prevent dryness and cracking. It is important that eczema sufferers use them even if the skin is looking healthy.

Topical steroids are mostly used during flare-ups. It is important to try to limit steroid use. Indeed, there are different strengths of steroids available, and your doctor will tell you which is the





best for your skin. Talk to your doctor about when and how to use these, and use them only as prescribed. Side effects can include thinning of the skin. There are other treatments available for more severe cases, and your doctor will decide whether referral to a specialist for further treatment is necessary.

Another thing to remember about eczema is that soaps and shower gels can often make it worse because they dry the skin. There are creams available which can be used as soap substitutes and can be prescribed by your doctor. It takes a bit of time and effort, but proper management of this skin condition can have good results, prevent the discomfort of itchy skin, and prevent infections. Dr Isabelle Duck is a GP and Urgent Care doctor at Westgate Medical Centre.

#### Do you get 'knots' in your muscles?

Well, you may or may not have been told that you have 'knots' in your muscles, however, that is NOT a medical term or diagnosis! Your muscles don't get knotted or bunched up when you get stressed, it's more likely that your muscles get tight from postural patterns. Most of us have experienced some form of muscle tightness whether it's from years of hard work, long hours of standing, sporting activities, incorrect breathing or life in general. This muscle tension can be relieved by massage and/or by changing your actions/habits e.g. the ergonomics of your work station; moving in various different ways to counteract repetitive movements and by staying active.

Trigger points (a phenomenon with mixed scientific evidence), are tender little nodules of tight bands within muscles, that may refer pain elsewhere in the body. These too, can be eliminated with massage, stretching and self-massage by using various balls and/or foam rollers.

#### Shoe Talk's Tips on how to fit shoes

Try both shoes on, you really want to have the footwear on both feet as it will feel different and sit differently on each foot. Also have you ever tried on a high heel when you had a sneaker on the other foot and then done the "bob-hop" around the shop? Buy the shoes that fit your larger foot. You can always make a shoe fit better with heel grips and insoles.

I love high heels, but ladies, if you are going to be walking a long distance, wear a pair of flats or sneakers and change over at your



destination.

There needs to be room for your toes, they should not feel cramped and in sports shoes you should be able to wiggle them up and down and side to side.

Try to select footwear that is shaped like your foot, if you have bunions, select footwear that has a nice supple or soft leather upper, so that it will stretch over this area.

Your heel should fit comfortably in the shoe with a minimum amount of slipping - the shoes should not ride up and down excessively on your heel when you walk.

Buy shoes with padded insoles and good out soles. These take the impact away from your joints.

Your foot bed should not be wider than the shoe, there should be no spill out, spill over, or ballet flats that do not cover the tops of your feet at all.

If you are selecting footwear and the ones you "love" don't fit correctly and the ones you "like" do, buy the ones you "like" your feet will "love" you forever!

#### Spice it up - swap sides of the bed

## Getting back to basics – growing vegetables

At Country Bears we are very fortunate to have space, so gardening and growing of vegetables, flowers and herbs are a very popular activity for our children. Ask a child where potatoes come from, and their response



might possibly be "the supermarket". As each generation passes by, it appears that life is getting busier, so convenient, quick access to food becomes the norm.

Using a bag made from recycled milk bottles (see photo below) and our numerous gardens around the centre, we are teaching the children how to grow, maintain and watch the growth of our gardens. Potatoes were recently planted in the recycled bag, which has a window flap at the bottom so the children can see the roots grow as well. Throughout this experience, the children were using mathematics, science, communication, numeracy, information, problem-solving, social, co-operative and physical skills. We had to measure the right amount of dirt to plant the potatoes in, and then measure again the amount of soil to cover. The children took turns with their peers, followed instructions from the teachers, and used their whole bodies to dig and transport the heavy soil into the bag and gardens. We have been watching the sprouts appear and measuring their growth, and waiting patiently until the time is right for us to dig them up.

Our on-site cook, alongside the children, will wash and prepare them, and we cannot wait to eat them! I wonder what the children will want to make with the potatoes – mashed, whole,



baked or maybe just plain old fashioned chips?

Korowai are the most highly prized of all traditional Māori garments and are regarded as family and personal heirlooms.



Children will wear the korowai on special occasions, particularly their 5-Year-Old leaving mat time. It is worn as a mantle and speaks of honour, dignity and respect. When we introduced our korowai to some of our children at mat time they immediately knew something special was happening. We could see how proud they were to be wearing it.

The introduction of the korowai sparked the imaginations of the children and inspired many of them to make their own korowai. We had been given beautiful fabric from the Mitchell family, which had now found its purpose at Kindergarten. Children started by choosing the fabric they wanted to use to make their korowai and the teachers helped cut their material to size. From there some children spent a long time planning and designing where their decorative pieces were to be placed. Others just set straight to gluing. All took ownership and were rightly proud of their work, showing their korowai off to others at Kindergarten. Once the korowai were made some children didn't want to



take them off and wore them as they played, proudly modelling them at mat time and home.

The introduction of what a korowai is and means has further developed our commitment to biculturalism and allowed the children to develop an understanding and respect for korowai and their place in Aotearoa New Zealand and our Kindergarten. Research clearly shows that positive and meaningful early experiences in mathematics are important for future success in education. Many young children are fascinated by numbers - they know that these digits mean something, and are keen to decode the mystery of how to use numbers to communicate and understand information. Early mathematics is not just addition, and subtraction. It includes looking at patterns, measuring, sorting, locating items, counting, grouping and identifying shapes.
